



Scheme of Work Conversation Classes (CL2)

Course Length: 48 Lessons Lesson Length: 100 minutes

Course Aims: (adapted from the CEFR 'Can do' statements for A2 Level)

By the end of the course students will be able to

- Understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of most immediate relevance (e.g. very basic personal and family information, shopping, local geography, employment).
- Communicate in simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and routine matters.
- Describe in simple terms aspects of my background, immediate environment and matters in areas of immediate need.
- Communicate in simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar topics and activities.
- Handle very short social exchanges.
- Use a series of phrases and sentences to describe in simple terms their family and other people, living conditions, their educational background and their present or most recent job.
- Use some simple structures correctly, but still systematically makes basic mistakes.
- Use basic sentence patterns with memorised phrases, groups of a few words and formulae in order to communicate limited information in simple everyday situations.
