



Student Welfare, Safeguarding & Pastoral Care

At Britannia English Academy, we understand that sending your child abroad is a big and important decision. During our Junior Summer Programme, your child's safety, wellbeing, and happiness are our highest priority. We are committed to providing a secure, supportive, and nurturing environment, where students feel cared for, protected, and confident throughout their stay in Manchester.

◆ Your child's safety, wellbeing, and happiness are our top priority.

We provide a secure, supportive, and nurturing environment throughout the Junior Summer Programme.

◆ Fully vetted and trained staff.

All staff undergo enhanced background checks (including DBS for UK-based staff) and receive regular safeguarding and emergency-preparedness training.

◆ Designated Safeguarding Team.

A named Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) is supported by a trained safeguarding team to monitor student welfare and respond to any concerns.

◆ Dedicated welfare and pastoral care team.

Our on-site welfare and pastoral care team supports students' emotional wellbeing, provides guidance, and responds immediately to any issues.

◆ Dedicated welfare staff on site.

A dedicated welfare staff member is present on each site to ensure immediate assistance and a caring environment for students.

◆ Constant, age-appropriate supervision.

Students are always supervised during lessons, activities, excursions, breaks, and transitions.

Supervision ratios are adapted to age groups, and unsupervised time is kept to a minimum.

◆ Clear rules and positive behaviour.

Students are introduced to school rules and expectations during induction.

We promote respectful, inclusive behaviour and a safe shared environment





◆ **Emotional wellbeing and pastoral support.**

Support is always available for homesickness, culture shock, friendship difficulties, or personal concerns.

◆ **Carefully selected accommodation.**

Junior students stay in vetted homestays or supervised residences.

◆ **Trained and briefed hosts and residential staff.**

Hosts and residential staff are trained and briefed on curfews, mealtimes, routines, and the specific needs of younger learners.

◆ **Ongoing accommodation welfare checks.**

Our accommodation team regularly checks in with both students and providers to ensure comfort, safety, and satisfaction.

◆ **Health and safety monitoring.**

Strict procedures are in place to monitor health and safety standards, including at student accommodations.

◆ **Medical and emergency support.**

Medical and emergency details are collected before arrival.

Trained first aiders are on site, and staff are trained in CPR and first aid. ○

◆ **Emergency communication with families.**

In the event of illness, accidents, or serious concerns, families are contacted immediately and kept fully informed.

◆ **Supervised activities and excursions.**

Juniors enjoy a full programme of age-appropriate activities and cultural excursions.

◆ **Risk-assessed trips.**

All off-site activities and excursions are fully risk-assessed and led by trusted staff or activity leaders.

◆ **Minimised unsupervised time.**

Free time is structured and supervised, with unsupervised time kept to an absolute minimum.

◆ **Regular check-ins and parent updates.**

Routine welfare check-ins are carried out, and parents receive regular updates on student wellbeing and activities. ▶▶▶▶▶
