

Safeguarding and Support for Under16s outside of Junior Summer School Programme

At Britannia English Academy, the safety and well-being of all students is our highest priority.

We recognise that students aged under 16, require an additional level of care and support appropriate to their age and maturity.

If you choose to trust us with the education of your child, you require clear details of how we support them and keep them safe.

We have robust safeguarding measures in place to ensure a safe and welcoming environment for young learners. These include:

- **Dedicated Safeguarding Staff:** Our trained Safeguarding Leads and welfare team are available throughout the student's stay to respond to any concerns and provide pastoral support. We have a Welfare Officer on site who will listen to and offer support with any problems a student may have.
- **Tailored Induction and Guidance:** Students aged under 16 receive clear guidance in their induction on safety, appropriate boundaries and who to turn to for help.

- **Lesson types:**

Outside of our summer programme, our group classes are suitable for adult students. We can, however, offer one-to-one lessons for your child. Your child will not mix with other adult students.

- **Getting your child to and from school:**

You must bring your child to school and sign them in at reception, and then collect them when their lesson is finished. We will not allow your child to leave the school unsupervised.

- **Supervision in school:**

Whilst in our school, your child will wait for their lesson in our reception area where they will be supervised by our staff.

They will then be escorted to their classroom by staff. When their lesson is finished, they will be escorted by their teacher back to reception.

- **Behaviour and Conduct Policies:** Clear policies are in place to ensure that classroom interactions and social spaces remain respectful and age-appropriate for younger students.
